

**PURPOSE:**

The purpose of this Aging Program Directive is to transmit to the Area Agencies on Aging (AAAs) the FY 12-13 amended SCSEP allocations and slots due to the relinquishment of SCSEP slots from the Northumberland County AAA to the PDA and the transfer of slots from the Armstrong County AAA and the Erie County AAA.

## **BACKGROUND and SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS:**

APD 12-05-02, which was issued on May 16, 2012, provided the AAAs with the FY 12-13 SCSEP dollar amounts and slot levels. The Northumberland County AAA recently notified the Department that it would be relinquishing its slots to the Department effective October 1, 2012. The Department has also transferred 3 slots from the Armstrong County AAA to the Erie County AAA, effective October 1, 2012, in order to achieve greater operating efficiencies for the Armstrong County AAA. Exhibit 1 contains the amended FY 12-13 SCSEP dollar amounts and slot levels for all AAAs. Please note that the dollar amounts and slot levels have only changed for the Erie, Northumberland and Armstrong County AAAs.

The Department will amend the FY 12-13 grant agreements for only the Erie, Northumberland and Armstrong County AAAs. In order to do this, the Erie, Northumberland and Armstrong County AAAs must submit revised FY 12-13 SCSEP budgets to the Department no later than September 27, 2012. The revised budgets must be submitted in accordance with the instructions on page 4 of APD 12-05-02
