AFFORDABLE CONNECTIVITY PROGRAM

- Up to \$30 per month off internet costs
- Up to \$100 off a device such as tablet or laptop for some participating providers
- Limited to one monthly service discount and one device discount per household.

AFFORDABLE CONNECTIVITY PROGRAM

ELIGIBLE HOUSEHOLDS:

- Income at or below 200% of federal poverty guidelines
OR
- Participation in several federal assistance programs including Medicaid, SSI, Veterans Pension and Lifeline
OR
- Meets eligibility criteria for reduced cost internet program with participating internet service providers.

AFFORDABLE CONNECTIVITY PROGRAM

- Two step enrollment process:
 1. Apply via AffordableConnectivity.gov or print out a mail-in application from that site.
 2. Contact the preferred participating provider to select a service plan and have the discount applied to the monthly bill.

Some providers may have an alternative application they will ask to be completed.

Eligible households must complete both steps to be enrolled and benefit from the program.
