

EMERGENCY BROADBAND BENEFIT





There are two benefits for consumers in the EBB program:

- One subsidy per household of <u>up to \$50 per month</u> on the price of internet service, or up to \$75 per month on Tribal lands. This can include modem/router fees. Savings will show on monthly bill.
- If your EBB service provider offers devices, a one-time discount of <u>up to</u> <u>\$100</u> off the price of a laptop, desk computer, or tablet purchased through the provider. (Mobile phones are not eligible.)
 - Consumers must contribute \$10 to \$50 towards the purchase price.
 - These devices must have wi-fi and a camera to support video.



There are several ways to be eligible for this program:

- Qualify for the <u>Lifeline</u> program;
- Receive benefits under the free and reduced-price school lunch program or the school breakfast program;
- Received a Federal Pell Grant during the current award year;
- Experienced a substantial loss of income since February 29, 2020, within specific income limits; or
- Meets the eligibility criteria for a participating providers' existing low-income or COVID-19 program.
