Area Agencies on Aging (AAAs) are advised that the Pennsylvania Department of Aging (PDA) has prepared APD #23-01-02 "Area Agency on Aging (AAA) Program Requirements, Planning Allocations and Aging Services Block Grant Format for FY 2022-23 Revision #2. It is available for electronic access on the PDA website.

Highlights of the updates in APD 23-01-02 include an overall \$77.2 (M) increase above the Cooperative Agreement allocations. The changes include:

- \$ 2.1 (M) Protective Services
- \$ 2.1 (M) Protective Services Personnel

- o \$1.1 (M) AAA Public Workforce Grant
- o \$1.5 (M) No Wrong Door Intake
- o \$422 (K) Direct Care Worker Pilot
