Purpose: The purpose of this Aging Program Directive (APD) is to provide notification

of rescinding APD #17-24-01 – Protective Service Quality Assurance Monitoring Protocol and updated policy and procedural requirements.

Background: The Pennsylvania Department of Aging (PDA) previously provided the Area

Agencies on Aging (AAA) with programmatic information and procedural guidance for older adult protective services through the issuance of Chapter VII: Protective Services of the *Aging Services Policy and Procedure Manual*. Major changes are as follows:

- The monitoring results of red, yellow, and green have been replaced with compliance and noncompliance.
- Protective Services Quality Assurance Monitoring results of one or more individuals identified as left at risk has been removed which previously resulted in a rating of Red.
